What is Listening to the Kyrgyz Republic?


- The L2KGZ survey provides high-frequency data on social and economic wellbeing. It was started in December 2021 and monitors well-being and opinions of a representative group of the population of the Kyrgyz Republic.
- This Brief analyzes dynamics of household wellbeing, financial security, food security, and perceptions of governance in the Kyrgyz Republic between December 2021 and February 2025.


REAL GDP GROWTH REMAINED STRONG AT 9 PERCENT (FOR A THIRD CONSECUTIVE YEAR) IN 2024




INCOME GROWTH BECAME MORE PRO-POOR IN 2023

Average Annual Income per capita (soms) by quintiles of consumption


Growth of per capita income












L2KGZ DATA SHOWS REAL WAGE GROWTH HAS STAGNATED OVER 2024









... AS WELL AS FOOD SECURITY WITH INCREASING NUMBER OF HHs NEED TO SELL ASSETS



IMPROVED FOOD SECURITY MEASURES INDICATE SIGNS OF DETERIORATION IN CERTAIN COMPONENTS




SOME DECLINE IN LIFE SATISFACTION AND JOBS IS TOP ECONOMIC CONCERNS FOR THE COUNTRY




L2 CA DATA SHOWS THAT JOBS ARE REGIONAL CONCERN

Share of Households reporting jobs as most pressing concern






INTERNATIONAL MIGRATION HAS DECLINED IN 2024 AND MOST OF REMITTANCES ARE USED FOR FOOD

Declining migration intentions




Spending patterns for remittances






Inflation Expectations Will Increase Faster PAST 30 DAYS - Increased Faster

"Inflation surprises" Index - Deviation between Expected and Perceived inflation




L2 CA DATA SHOWS THAT INFLATION CONCERNS ARE HIGHER IN KAZAKHSTAN AND UZBEKISTAN

Share of Households reporting prices as most pressing concern





KEY MESSAGES

1. Economic Wellbeing & Financial Security

- Real wage growth stagnated in 2024.
- Financial and Food security declined slightly.

2. Public Perception & Economic Concerns

- Life satisfaction declined, with jobs as the top economic concern.
- Despite declining indicators, public perception of economic conditions and the labor market remains high.

3. Poverty & Governance Perceptions

- Despite stagnant incomes, subjective poverty levels remained stable.
- A majority believe the government is engaging in open dialogue and fighting corruption.
- However, perceptions of the country being on the right track are slightly declining.
